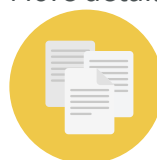

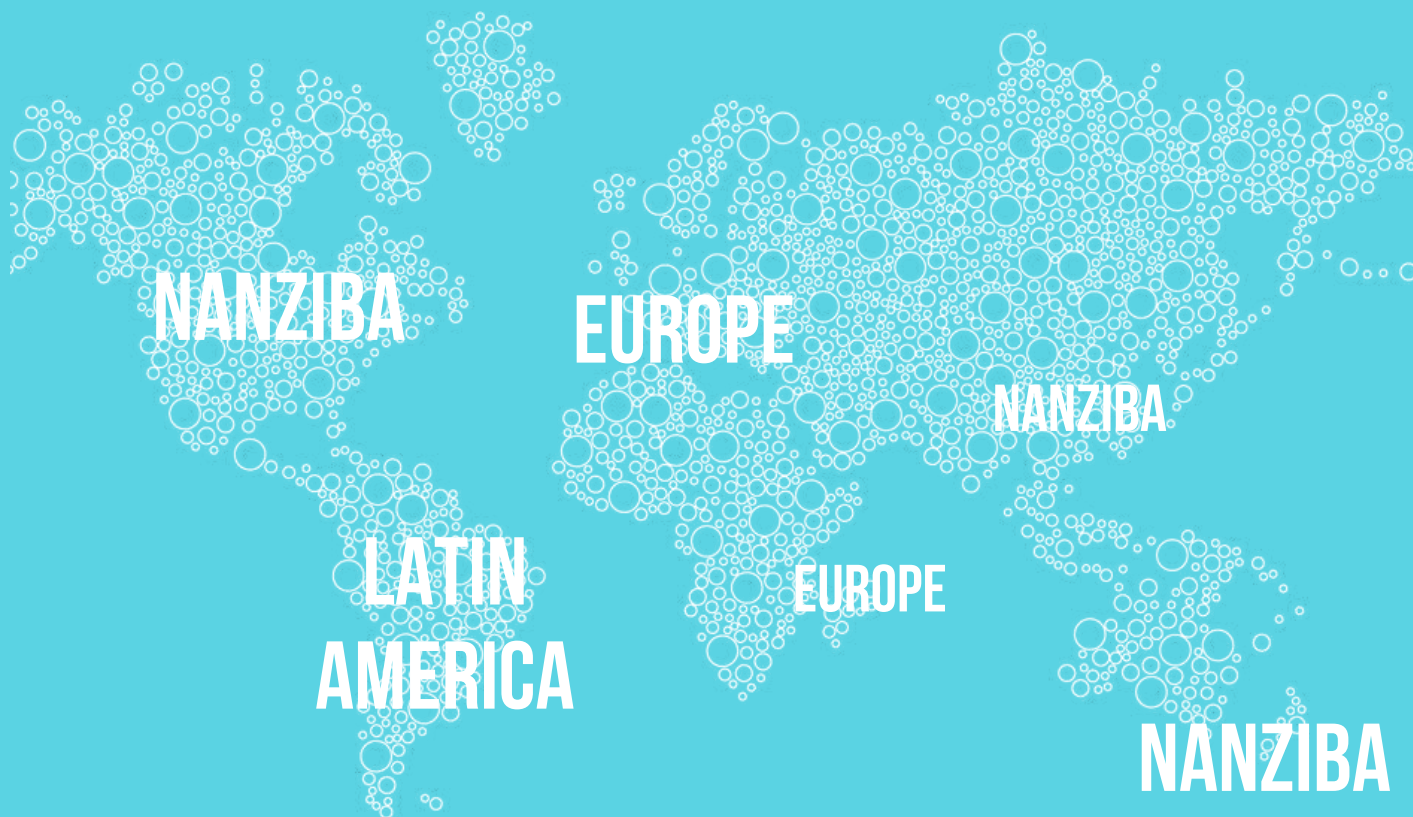

## BoT



The **BoT** is committed to growing a method of organizational self-governance.

- An organization in which members can maintain a healthy allegiance to a bioenergetic center that holds the interests of members around the world, and also participate in local autonomous organizations.
- This is what members have asked for, and the BoT has tried to model this way of relating to each other organizationally, with respect for the affiliated societies and federations, with an awareness of the interests of those members who have no local or regional affiliation, and with a guiding commitment to the interests and welfare of all the members.
- This part of the organizational mission is advanced by the IIBA acting to coordinate the activities of bioenergetic groups worldwide.
- This includes developing means of communication between affiliated societies, regional groups, and between members that enhance information and knowledge sharing, and thereby enhance members' competence.

## EC



The **EC** is to execute the policies of the IIBA.

The **EC** shall manage the current business of the organization in accordance with the Mission Statement and Goals of the organization as defined by the BoT.

These include, among other things, making decisions on:

- current business,
- appointing Chairs of Committees and Working Groups and appointing coordinators for specific tasks,
- keeping in contact with the IIBA International Faculty and overseeing teaching activities,
- presenting a yearly budget and yearly report on the financial situation of the IIBA to the membership; overseeing the organization of the International Conference,
- and officially representing the IIBA outside the organization.

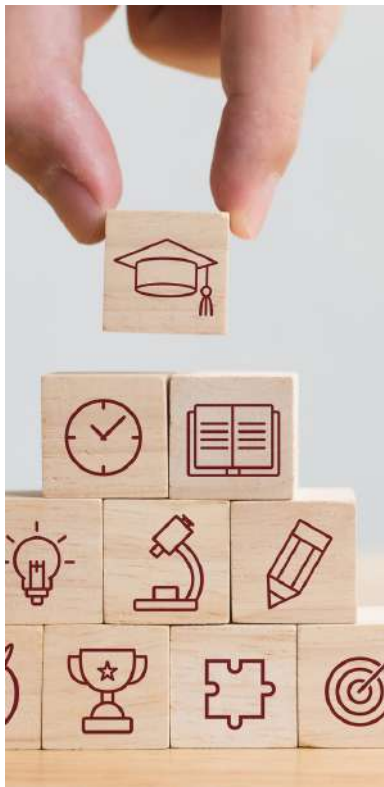
They represents and speaks on behalf of the International Faculty to other IIBA committees.

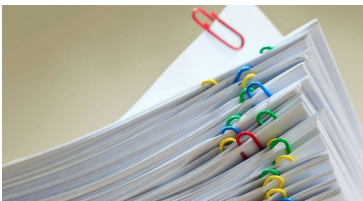

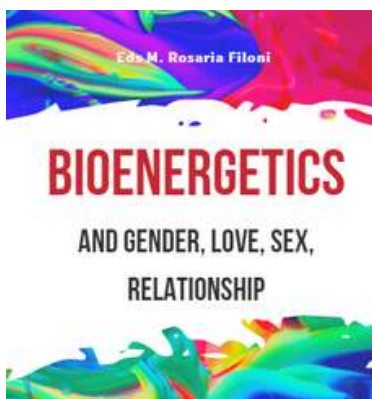
