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
## WELCOME

## REVIEW 2021

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Vita Heinrich-Clauer gives a short review about 2021:

### **Celebration of gender, sexual & bodily diversity**

The BoT included a special statement on the website:

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*We are founded on principles of acceptance of the human in all of us, and in the equal value of all human beings. We are aware that structural racism and inequities affect every society and organization and we are united in our struggle to face and restrain the destructive in ourselves and those we work with. We are committed to amend any policy and practice that perpetuates inequality or injustice within our organization and within the scope of our stated mission.*

*The members of the IIBA share in the sorrow, grief and outrage felt by many in response to the growing awareness of the destructive practices and policies against bodies of color. We stand in solidarity with those who recognize how the legacy of racial oppression and the instruments of institutionalized racism have contributed to the over-representation of black, brown, and indigenous people among those killed by Covid-19. This acting out of destructiveness goes directly against the philosophy and mission of the IIBA.*

## Further actions

The BoT has been thinking hard about how the IIBA can help dismantle the systemic racial barriers that for generations have blocked social and economic progress for black, brown, and indigenous people. The BoT, in collaboration with the Organizing Committee of the 26<sup>th</sup> IIBA International Conference – Virtual Pre-Conference decided to offer a discount of 70 % for black, brown, and indigenous people. Anybody who declared herself/himself as black, brown, and indigenous people, was able to register using the discount code.

11 persons applied for the discount code (1 person from Nanziba and 10 persons from Latin America).

When we think about the last 1,5 years, we have learned a big deal about how to connect, engage and to build bridges or maintaining relationships. We learned more about our resources and deficiencies as an organization forced to go virtual. ## FEEDBACK & DISCUSSION



We opened the floor to feedback from the society leaders:

Society: Name	Topic & feedback
New York Society for Bioenergetic Analysis: Danita Hall	<p><b>Black, brown, and indigenous people:</b> Great that we are offering a discount. It may be better to state it as discounts for non-white participants who cannot afford to pay. The offering implies people of color can't afford to pay and that is another discrimination.</p> <p>Suggestion to change it going forward to wording that “offers” if you are not able to pay, we have a discount available.</p> <p><b>Pandemic:</b> We came back in person in July. We asked everyone to be vaccinated. One person did not want to get vaccinated but did finally and joined us. Also, just before the training, everyone gets a Covid test so we can be together without wearing masks and it makes a huge difference to our training. People may feel safer coming if everyone is required to be vaccinated.</p>
In the name of the SC-PDW Committee: Alex Munroe	<p><b>PDW 2022:</b> Planning an in-person PDW in Summer 2022. Looking for a new location because the former location in Belgium is not allowing bookings. Maybe Oslo (Norway). Updates will follow soon.</p>
In the name of the Organizing and Scientific Committee: Liane Zink	<p><b>26<sup>th</sup> IIBA International Conference – Virtual Pre-Conference:</b> It is/was a pre-conference not a conference. The real conference will hopefully happen next year. Organizing the virtual pre-conference was a really big job on the internet.</p>
Instituto de Análise Bioenergética de São Paulo: Liane Zink	<p><b>Discount for black, brown, and indigenous people:</b> We are giving a discount only if they need. In our institute we are doing a teaching program and we have black people helping with how to deal with this issue. We are not just saying black people are poor and they get a discount. It's going great in Brazil.</p>
Süddeutsche Gesellschaft für Bioenergetische Analyse: Wera Fauser	<p><b>Travelling in 2022:</b> Our members look forward to going somewhere.</p> <p><b>Pandemic:</b> Situation is not “too bad”. Many are calling and want to come in person, even more than before Covid.</p>

Dallas Society for Bioenergetic Analysis: Linda Hines	<b>Pandemic:</b> Hopefully it will be better soon. Right now, we are on-line.
Collège Français d'Analyse Bioénergétique: Guy Tonella	<b>Travelling:</b> I am beginning to travel for training (Spain in October and Réunion in November). Not China yet and not possible to go from Europe to the US or South America at this time.
In the name of the BoT and Coordinating Trainer for the Training Groups in Poland: Vita Heinrich-Clauer	<b>Pandemic &amp; Travelling:</b> We have been training from May. We decided on quick tests every morning. There is much debate and discussion. Countries that don't have quick test we bring for them. We tell them this is for the trainees, for the safety of the trainees. Germany is not obligated to vaccinate.
In the name of the upcoming training group for Detroit/Guelph: Ann L-K Coleman	<b>Pandemic &amp; Travelling:</b> Ann in Detroit and Alex in Guelph are starting a training together, combining US and Canadian people. With the border opening the plan is to meet in person in April 2022.
Massachusetts Society for Bioenergetic Analysis: Laurie Ure	<b>Pandemic:</b> Challenge in our training group is that some are choosing not to vaccinate. Very painful and a difficult conflict that we are having to manage. Those trainees chose to drop out of training. Difficult because we value inclusiveness and everyone's position. We are meeting online now and hope to be in person in April. Massachusetts Conference is requiring full vaccination.
In the name of the New Zealand Society for Bioenergetic Analysis: Diana Guest	<b>Pandemic:</b> End of March (2022) I am supposed to go to New Zealand. We hope New Zealand will be open.
Società Italiana di Analisi Bioenergetica: Patrizia Moselli	<b>Pandemic:</b> Since June we are in-person. We can travel. Most are fully vaccinated, so we can work without masks. Nevertheless, there are people against the vaccine. (2 people quit training instead of getting vaccinated.) A few teachers were also against vaccination.  <b>Travelling 2022:</b> Maybe, the PDW and the in-person conference should not be held in the same year. BoT must talk more about this. I hope that the conference can happen in Brazil. A small location may be safer than the big city (like Sao Paulo).
China Training Group: Rebecca Jianpu	<b>Pandemic:</b> Most are vaccinated. Waiting for trainers to be able to travel. They are longing for them to be able to come.  We have 9 CBT's now and we formed supervision weekly peer groups and meet & talk about cases; read books together like Bend into Shape and Vibrant Way to Health. We are trying to help ourselves to grow while we wait for trainers, therapists & supervisors to return. Hopefully in May we will start again.



	We also have some online workshops and many people are new and look forward to join the next new training group.
Israeli Society for Bioenergetic Analysis: Yael Lee	<p><b>Pandemic:</b> The society has been meeting since April since we were all vaccinated.</p> <p><b>Travelling:</b> Brazil is very far and not certain that people will travel this time.</p> <p>The training group is supposed to start in a couple weeks but we are waiting to see if Scott Baum's Visa will be approved.</p>

What are non-active members?

- Non-active members: Any new or dropped-out member in previous years who has not paid IIBA membership dues 2021.

## Further conditions

- Deadline for payment: The dues 2022 are payable on or before December 15, 2021. Unpaid members as of January 1, 2022 will lose membership privileges until their dues are paid.
- Discount period: Our affiliated societies and members at large (MAL) can apply for the special Covid-19 discount during the dues 2022 period. The dues 2022 period starts on September 1, 2021 and finishes on December 15, 2021. The Covid-19 discount is not valid for dues 2021 payments received after December 15, 2021.
- Discount exception: The Covid-19 discount does not apply when it comes to the “exceptional dues arrangement for becoming CBT” (BoT decision from June 29, 2017).
- Currency for dues payments: Dues 2022 can be paid in EUR or USD.

As always, our local societies and / or training groups will collect the dues of the affiliated IIBA members and will pay the total amount of dues in one sum and in due time to us. In addition, please send an updated list of our membership including postal address and email as well as

the amount paid by each member. This list has to be returned to us together with the payment by December 15, 2021 (deadline).
