

Regular Professor of the Master's Program in Latin American Contemporary Aesthetics (UNDAV). Member of the Academic Committee and Professor of the Doctorate in Arts and Technoaesthetics at the National University of Tres de Febrero (UNTREF).

SUSANA YASAN'S BIO

Certified Bioenergetic Therapist by the International Institute for Bioenergetic Analysis (IIBA). I work as an actress and theater director, graduated from the ISA of the Teatro Colón. Specialized in bioenergetic training, body therapeutic techniques, coordination of body techniques, relational psychomotricity. I direct the Latin American School of Bioenergetics, Body and Integrated Creative Techniques, both in Argentina and in other Latin American countries. I coordinate training groups for healthcare, art, and education professionals, and also conduct experiential workshops on body, energy, and creative action. I have been invited by various countries such as Panama, Brazil, Peru, Mexico, Uruguay, Colombia, and Ecuador to train professionals in bioenergetics and creative techniques. Currently, I reside in Miami since 2022, where I teach the MAB-Bioenergetics Method for actors at the Hispanic-American Actors Society.
